**Inferences:**

1. Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram and Sikkim enjoy more or less **Normal** rainfall since 1<sup>st</sup> June to till 31<sup>st</sup> August 2016.
2. Rainfall in Assam is in slightly deficit range, but the deficiency is a very mild one.
3. Manipur faced severely scarce rainfall in June and July but came back to normal condition in August.
4. Rainfall in Tripura is constantly improving in every month.
5. Rainfall deficit in Meghalaya and Nagaland are of matter of concern till date.
