Important Instructions

Duly completed Application Form should be sent by Registered Post, Courier or by Hand to Pankaj Baiswar (Plant Pathology), Secretary, Indian Association of Hill Farming (IAHF), & Senior Scientist, Division of Crop Science, ICAR Research Complex for NEH Region, Umiam-793103, Meghalaya, so as to reach not later than 20th November, 2021.

- IAHF calls for fellowship positions for 2019 and 2020 (Total 8 positions)
- A total of four fellows will be selected every year across the disciplines (not more than 02 fellows to be selected in any discipline in a single year).
- Award carries a certificate and a memento.
- To be considered for the fellow position of the society, the total service length should be at least 15 years of which at least 3 years in hills.
- Life membership of IAHF for a minimum period of 03 year is prerequisite.
- Attach evidence for service in Hill station and reprint of 10 most important research papers.
- Provide soft copy of application along evidences for publication/other claim in the CD with appropriate headings for easy reference.
- Claims without evidence (soft copy) will not be considered for scoring.
- Provide a detail list of publications (with NAAS ratings if applicable) under adequate heading and subheadings as word file in CD (Naas Rating of Year 2019 will be followed).
- Submit **TWO COPIES** of Application
- An amount of Rs. 3000/- (Rupees Three thousand) only to be paid as processing fees through online transfer to the society account and payment details to be send along with the duly filled application form

- Application not received within closing dates will not be considered.
- Only application forwarded through Head of the Institute/ IAHF Fellow/ Fellow of any recognized professional National Society will be entertained by the society (*Proof to be attached by the person forwarding the application in case of Fellow other than IAHF*).
- Before applying for the IAHF fellowships, the applicants are requested to verify that they fulfill above requirements. Candidates not meeting above requirements will not be considered for the IAHF fellow.
- Final decision of Society President will be binding in all cases.
- Achievements/ Publication etc up to the closing date will be considered for IAHF Award irrespective of year of Award.
- Complete application (hard copy) may be kept within 75 pages including enclosures.
