Abstracts in different theme areas will be selected for oral/poster presentation in each session. The size of the poster should be 48" (L) X 36" (W). Maximum 20 min will be allotted to lead speakers and 5 minutes to the presenters.

English will be the official language of the Symposium.

in MS Word typed in single space and maximum of 300 words (excluding title, affiliation etc.). The title (14 points/Arial) should be followed by name of Author/Authors with the name of the person presenting underlined and their affiliation (12 points /Arial). Abstracts should not contain more than 300 words (excluding title, affiliation etc.).

Printing and processing charges of 250/- for each abstract (should be sent through Bank draft or electronic payment).

Abstracts will be screened before acceptance.
