

Training cum Exposure visit for progressive farmers under NAIP

A two days training cum exposure visit for 14 progressive farmers of Upper Subansiri & West Siang district under NAIP project was successfully organized at Lakshmi Agriculture Multipurpose Project, Pabhoi in Biswanath Chirali district of Assam. Farmers were trained in the field of organic farming, paddy cum fish culture, vermicompost, Bio-pesticides, System of Rice Intensification (SRI) and composite fish culture.
